In partnership with the artisan team at **Sugar Leaf Coffee Roasterie**, Love Cafe is bringing a sophisticated, creative menu to S. Kinnickinnic Ave. Whether you're a purist who needs a solid pour-over or a trend-chaser looking for something unique, they've got you covered.

Must-try seasonal specialties include:

- **The Purple Drink:** A stunning matcha or espresso beverage balanced with ube-sweetened oat milk.
- **Tiramisu Cold Brew:** Topped with decadent vanilla bean mascarpone, cacao, and a cookie, it's basically dessert for breakfast.
- **Alive With the Glory of Love:** A complex, refreshing iced tea made with cacao husk, hibiscus rose, and lime—a mouthful in both title and flavor.

The cafe is also leaning heavily into customization. You can elevate any drink with their housemade syrups, ranging from floral **lavender** and **vanilla bean** to the earthy, aromatic notes of **ube** and **palo santo**. For the matcha purists, they're sourcing ceremonial-grade powder straight from Shizuoka, Japan, available in vibrant mango or strawberry-rose flavor profiles.

No morning coffee run is complete without a treat, and Love Cafe is making sure everyone has a place at the table. Their bakery case will feature a rotating selection of muffins and cookies, with a strong focus on inclusivity.
